The Reason for God, Timothy Keller

DVD and discussion guide, six sessions

Pastor and author Timothy Keller meets with a group of people to address their doubts and objections to Christianity, using literature, philosophy, real-life experiences, and the Bible.

Forgotten God: Reversing our Tragic Neglect of the Holy Spirit, Francis Chan

DVD and interactive workbook, seven sessions

Author Francis Chan reminds us of the true source of the church's power--the Holy Spirit. Sessions offer an invitation to understand, embrace, and follow the Holy Spirit's direction.

The Truth Project, Focus on the Family

DVD, twelve one-hour sessions

Small group study designed to equip believers with a comprehensive biblical worldview. Lessons discuss God's design for living out the Christian worldview in daily life and the need to act upon our core beliefs.

The Shelter of God's Promises, Sheila Walsh

DVD, participant's guide, leader's guide, ten 25-30 minute sessions

Bible teacher and Women of Faith speaker Sheila Walsh searches Scripture for what God has promised us, what God's promises mean, and how encounters with Christ are the eternal fulfillment of His unrelenting commitment to us.

The Invisible War, Chip Ingram

DVD, eight sessions

What every believer needs to know about Satan, demons and spiritual warfare. Topics include: Who are we fighting? How to prepare yourself for spiritual battle and The Christian's secret weapon, among others.

Living on the Edge, Chip Ingram

DVD and study guide, ten sessions

Author Chip Ingram dares you to experience true spirituality. Romans 12 offers a picture of how authentic disciples live out their faith. Topics include: How to give God what He wants the most, How to come to grips with the real you, and How to experience authentic community, among others.

Breaking Free, Beth Moore

DVD and leader guide, eleven sessions (revised version)

Breaking Free: Making Liberty in Christ a Reality in Life leads you through a study of the Scriptures to discover the transforming power of Christian freedom. Based on Isaiah 61:1-4, this study draws parallels between the captive Israelites and today's believers.
