### HAITI DISASTER RELIEF KITS

*From the Encouragers Ministry in partnership with Colonial Kids & Families, Student Ministries, Child Development Center, LIFE Groups and Deacon Board*

Here is your “hands on” chance to impact individuals and families affected by the recent earthquake in Haiti. Donated “Relief Kits” which will be given to the Heart to Heart, and shipped to Haiti for individuals and families in need. The kits will be used to meet the most basic human needs.

#### Care Kit Contents

- One new hand towel
- One new washcloth
- One wide-tooth comb
- One 10 oz bottle of shampoo
- One new individually wrapped toothbrush
- One regular size tube toothpaste
- Ten adhesive bandages
- One regular size bath soap
- One travel soap holder (or Ziploc bag for soap)
- Two one-gallon size Ziploc bags

1. Double-bag the care items: place all items in one Ziploc bag, seal it and place the top of the filled bag in bottom of second bag and seal it.
2. If you have 10 or more kits, collect banana boxes from the grocery store or Xerox paper boxes. Place cardboard or a paper bag in bottom and place 10 completed Care Kits in box. (No additional items.)
3. Deliver to the Quivira or Wornall campuses on Sundays or during the week, now through the end of February.
4. We will also be accepting singular care kits or groups less than 10.
